This term our enquiry question is "Is someone always to blame for a disaster?" We



We are going to have a big push on handwriting and presentation as we move into our final year of KS1 so any support at home with handwriting would be great!

In maths this term we are going to continue to develop our learning on numbers to 100 before moving onto addition and subtraction. TopMark's has some great maths games to support the children's learning which is free to access online, on a computer, IPad or phone!
